## On Court Coach

(The person who makes sure everything gets done!)

- 1. Calls morning huddles (2) and afternoon huddle as required
- 2. Ensures all entries on the treatment room board are correct and updated as required
- 3. Matches vet/nurse pairs
- Ensures everybody is in their optimal roles throughout the day (vets and nurses)
- 5. Ensures that all patients are health checked and that blood is drawn and run as required
- 6. Ensures surgery patients are premeded in a timely manner depending on surgery vet timetable
- 7. Ensures medical patients have cage cards with clear instructions regarding frequency of observations required by the vet/nurses, what and when with regards to meds, fluids etc

That patients are given access to food and water as appropriate.

## **During the day**

8. Checks washing situation and makes sure that it proceeds throughout the day as necessary

## Later

- 9. Ensures folders/bags are made up, handwritten instructions to clients are clear, and take-home drugs are made up.
- 10. Ensures post op and medical patients' owners have been updated and discharge times, as appropriate, have been arranged
- 11. Ensures accounts are finalised and discharge instructions are clear
- 12. Ensures administration tasks are prioritised, completed or rescheduled.
